The Wilmington Fur Ball is a one-night fund-raising event that, for 14 years, has donated over \$266,000 to no-kill animal shelters and animal groups in New Hanover, Pender, and Brunswick counties. Because of the covid virus we have not been able to host this event for the last 3 years. We are pleased to announce that the 15th event, the Furball Crystal Jubilee, will take place on November 4, 2023, at the Plaza on Princess in downtown Wilmington.

All profits are donated to rescue groups, who are the heroes who gave these animals a second chance by rescuing, healing, rehabilitating, and rehoming them. The 2019 grant recipients were:
